



This guide will help you create an estimated investment plan for your home design project. The prices listed in the table are based on my experience and current market. The prices listed are also estimates based on the quality of the product (materials, fabrics, hardware etc.). This guide is not meant to be an end-all-be-all for project investment, but rather a help by giving you an idea what goes into planning a project. Keep in mind that there are many details and costs associated with completing a project, including designer, contractor, electrician etc., that must be factored in. These costs can vary depending on the scale and scope of the project. Use this guide to outline and price most of what you want/need and let us help you put the rest together with our Signature Service.

WHERE DO I START?



When planning any changes in your home, knowing precisely how much money you have to invest is crucial. Even if you have no idea what things cost, there is usually a number in mind within your comfort zone.

- 1. Decide on a project ask yourself these questions:
- What is the reason you are renovating?
- How long are you planning to be in your home?

If you're planning to stay in your home long-term it may make sense to splurge to create your dream space. However, if you're thinking about selling the home within a few years, focusing on your potential return on investment and what you can take with you is a good idea.

- 2. Determine exactly what you want down to the small details
 List of exactly what you want can help you come up with a more accurate
 amount to invest. Be sure to include fixtures, finishes, and furnishings.
 - Use the inventory list to itemize the current items you have and your plans for them. I can offer great insight on using things you already own. They can also be redone to fit your new design (i.e hardware, upholstery, color etc.)

3. Figure out the value

To get an approximate idea of what your investment should be, consider the value of your home as a whole; 15% - 20% of your homes current value can be a good starting point.

4. Plan for unexpected expenses

Once you know how much your investment should be, consider setting aside an extra 10 to 20 percent. You never know what you're going to find once you start tearing down walls. It can always go toward furnishings if you wind up not using it.

CREATING THE INVESTMENT PLAN



Use Microsoft Excel (PC), Google Sheets (best for collaborating) or Numbers (MAC)

- 1.Create a room-by-room spreadsheet
- List all the items needed
 - -Include items such as fixtures, finishes, furnishings
 - -Include paint, knobs, faucets, tile, flooring
- -Include the appliances you want (don't forget installation, delivery and disposal of old items)
- Create 3 columns
 - Investment initial researched cost
- Projection adjusted cost (as the project progresses and some of the prices seem too low or too high list)
 - Actual cost once the item has been ordered
 - Include a column automatically adding 6.625% for taxes, 20% for shipping and delivery. This is an estimated cost, it can vary.
 - Master bathrooms requiring demo for space should have a baseline investment of \$45,000 +.
 - Kitchens have many ways of being addressed in design. \$55,000 + is a baseline investment, depending on the approach. This baseline would not necessarily include furniture and window treatments.
- 2. Duplicate the above for your team spreadsheet or second tab on current room sheet

- **** Consider what living expenses you will incur during your project. Consider the costs for living without a functioning kitchen, boarding pets or staying outside the home during your project and include these costs in your spreadsheet****

TIPS



- Refurbish valued older items. Instead of replacing all high-cost items, such as furniture, we can figure out what is worth keeping. Older items that are made well are great once they are given a new look, repurposed, or relocated. I personally enjoy incorporating vintage items and my client's heirlooms into a new design.
- Resist adding things along the way. This is called "Scope Creep". As the renovation moves along, you may be tempted to tack on another small item here and there, but "change" orders can be expensive. Stick to the plan once it has begun or understand that there will be additional costs for labor and product, etc.
- Be open to working in phases. Sometimes what we want does not match our ability to acquire at a given point in time. We can help you figure out the priorities and the best order of projects to be done.
- Do not start a project with an upcoming event in mind. If you want a lot of stress, this will do it. Projects can last anywhere from 4-6 months, even a year, depending on the scope. Custom upholstery may take 8-12 weeks to come in.





TIPS

 Do not wait for the spring to contact Designer/Contractor. The best time to line up who you need for a spring project is in the previous fall. Even if you are managing the project yourself, contractors are booked 4-6 months in advance these days. If you wait until you are ready, they may not have room on their calendar for your project. As an interior designer, the plans, selections and orders have to be taken care of and delivered before a contractor gets started.
